

# Candy Close-Up in Color (131)

(Analogous scheme)

## Assignment Due Date:

Week 9, Monday, 03-05, 2 pm

## Media:

18" x 24" Heavyweight Sketch Paper, Colored Chalk pastels (supplemented as needed with brighter pastels), one or a few pieces of brightly colored candy (no wrappers, chocolate is not recommended.)

## Assignment:

Lay the candy on some paper. Ideally you will lay them on colored paper that is in your color scheme. If you don't have the right color, use white but invent the color of the background for your drawing. **Based on the color of your candy, decide on a color scheme: monochromatic, analogous, complimentary, double complimentary or triadic.**



Thumbnailing is recommended to find an excellent composition. Consider letting your candy go beyond the edges of the page in some areas. Think about the principles of design: positive and negative space, balance, repetition, rhythm. unity and variety.

### On the final drawing:

*Very lightly* sketch the candy in a light color (yellow or orange or light green depending on the color of the candy). Lay out the entire composition before coloring in. If the line drawing has composition problems, correct them before continuing with the color values. Use layered mixtures of your colors whenever possible to obtain the colors that you observe in the candy

Don't forget to use a harmonious color as your background and that shadows on that background will be a combination of the color of the background and the color of the shadow-not one or the other.

DO NOT USE BLACK AT ALL! CREATE LOW VALUED COLORS BY LAYERING BLUES AND VIOLETS
