Assignment:

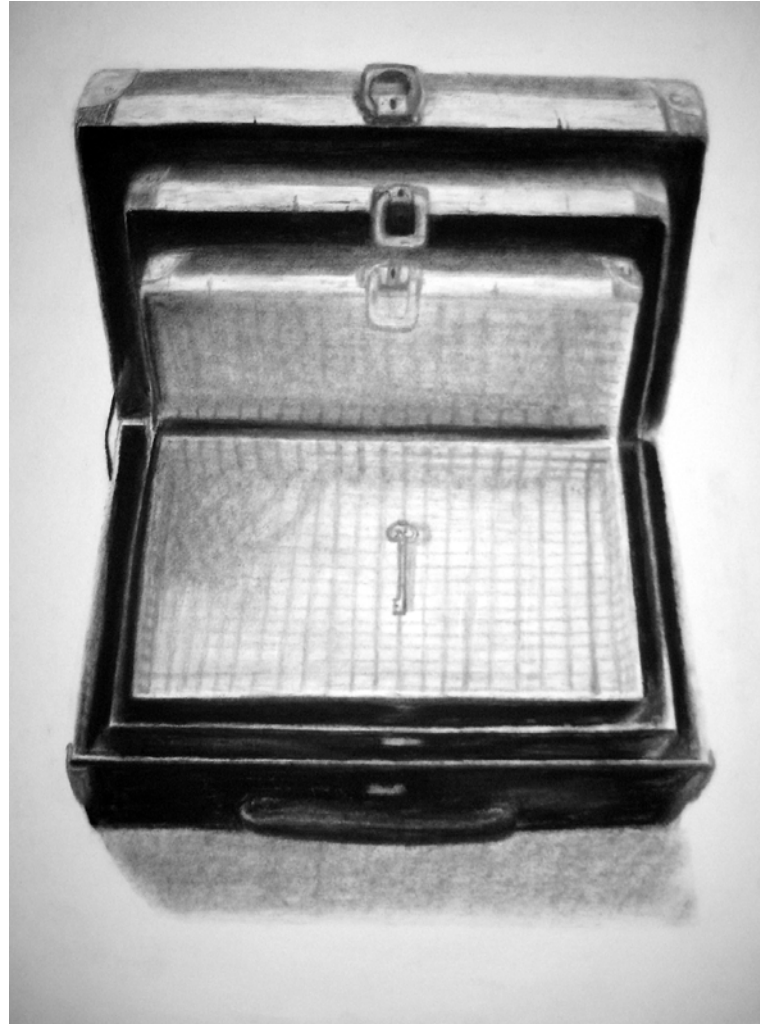
