Assignment Due Date:

Media: 18" x 24" Nice Drawing Paper, Charcoal Pencil, compressed charcoal, Gum Eraser, Ruler

Assignment:

Draw 10 3" x 3" squares, evenly spaced with borders on all sides. Longest sides will have 2.5" edge borders. Leave 1" between all squares. Use your 20 thumbnails assignment as a template, the measurements are the same as the two middle rows.

Once the borders are drawn:

Fill each square with the close up study of a texture. Make 10 distinctly different textures using varied combinations of the 3 elements that make up texture: **line, shape and value.**

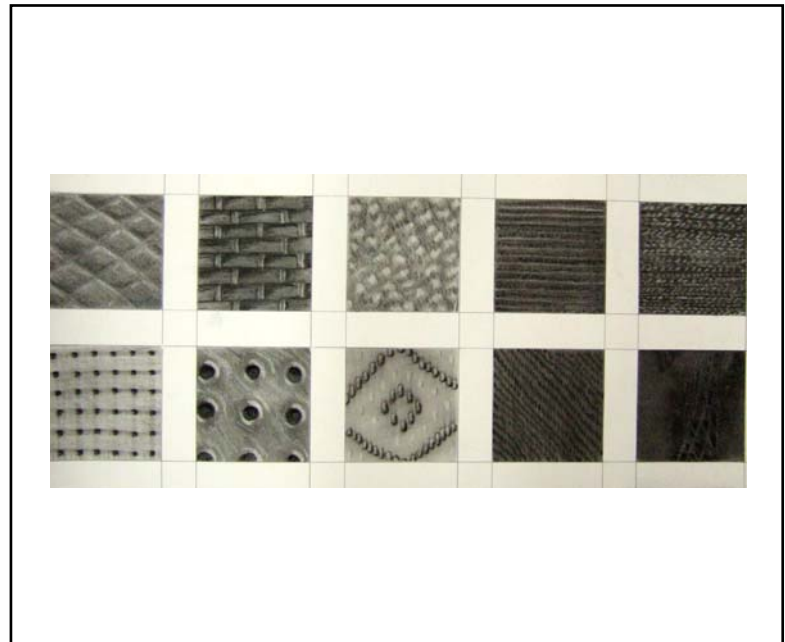
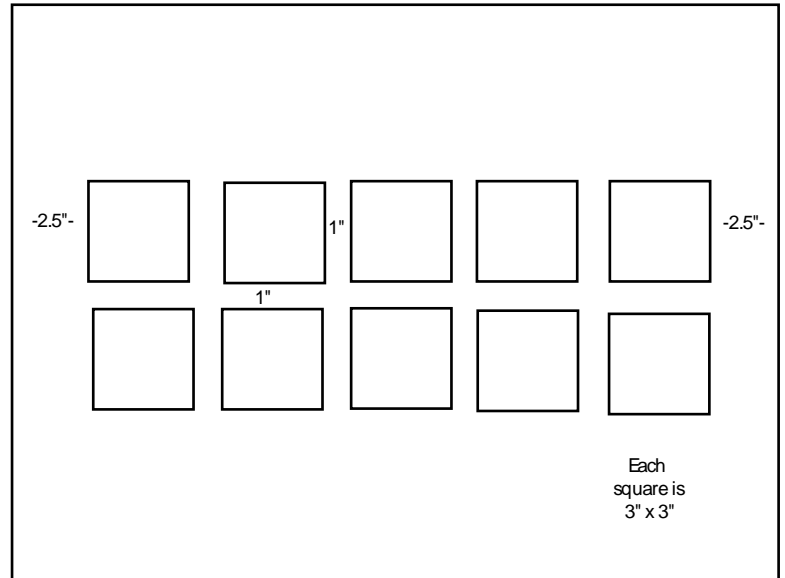
Do:

- Fill each square with close up texture
- Use varied line, value and shape in each example
- Use distinctly different textures, (not 6 different types of knitted sweaters)

Don't:

- draw the object that the texture appears on in the box, just the texture close up.
- make rubbings of textured surfaces (it's cheating)

Here are 25 textures you are likely to have access to: wood, sponge, cereal, salt, concrete, hairbrush, hair, skin, woven, knitted, leather, bath towel, paper towel, glass, metal, liquid, grass, leaves, bark, denim, stitching, French fry, hamburger patty, lettuce, sandpaper
