

20 Thumb-nails for the best composition (131)

Assignment Due Date:

Week 3, Monday, 01-23, 2 pm

Media: 18" x 24" Newsprint, Charcoal Pencil or black or blue pen, Gum Eraser, Ruler

Assignment:

Use Line only, no shading for this assignment.

Draw 20 3" x 3" squares, evenly spaced with borders on all sides. Longest sides will have 2.5" edge borders, shorter sides will have 1.5" edge borders. Leave 1" between all squares. If your paper is not quite 18"x 24", take away or add to the edge borders.

Once the borders are drawn:
Either set up a still life or use things that are already placed around your home. You may do 20 different thumbnails or stick with the same few objects for all of the drawings.

Use a viewfinder (or imagine one) to find the best compositions. Close in on just a few objects, or parts of objects. Allow the objects to become less recognizable while maintaining their true shapes. Use the whole box but allow open areas. Let your compositions go beyond the boxes.

Think about the principles of design:
positive and negative space, balance, repetition, rhythm. unity and variety.
