

Assignment #4: Volume-Inside and Out

Due Date: Tuesday, 02-07

Materials:

-sketchbook, pencil, plaster bandage, scissors and 1 gallon bucket/mixing bowl . You will need other supplies depending on your solution to the problem. Wire cutters and hot glue guns are available to you during class time. A balloon will be provided.

Finished project size: Approximately 1' x 1' x 1' (or larger if you like)

Project Summary:

3-D Design Elements: Shape, Volume, Texture

Organizing Principles of Design: Unity and Variety, Contrast

Construction Method: Assemblage

In this assignment you will be creating a simple vessel, a voluminous space. This will be done by wrapping a balloon (or your hand or foot) with plaster bandage. You will treat the interior surface and the exterior surface of the volume in a way that creates contrast and texture. The best work will have a connection between the surface treatments and the shape of the volume.

Some ways you could make your surfaces contrast:

Add Smooth or textured plaster

Glue textures to the surface (fabrics, objects, etc)

Paint the surface

Apply Gold Leaf or Aluminum foil

Do:

Consult the color wheel about color contrasts

Make two very distinctly contrasting surfaces (paint on both sides is not so interesting)
